Trainees who are expected to complete their Higher Specialist Training by 31st December 2026 (including at least 1 year of general O&G training) can now apply for the coming Exit Assessment in January 2027. They will have to submit their applications for the Assessment to the College **not later than 30th October 2026**. Such applications will be received and approved by the Education Committee.
